PURCHASE SNOWMOBILE REGISTRATIONS IN FREMONT COUNTY

Idaho State Law requires snowmobile registrations on all snowmobiles. Registrations are available at local vendors. Off-trail travel can be hazardous due to barbed wire fences, creek crossings and rocks.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

1. Speed limit 45 miles per hour.
2. Stay on designated trails while traveling through restricted areas.
3. Pack out all litter.
4. Be aware of oncoming traffic. KEEP RIGHT, two-way traffic.
5. DON'T DRINK and DRIVE!
6. Beware of moose, elk and bison on trails.

SNOW SAFETY: REMEMBER

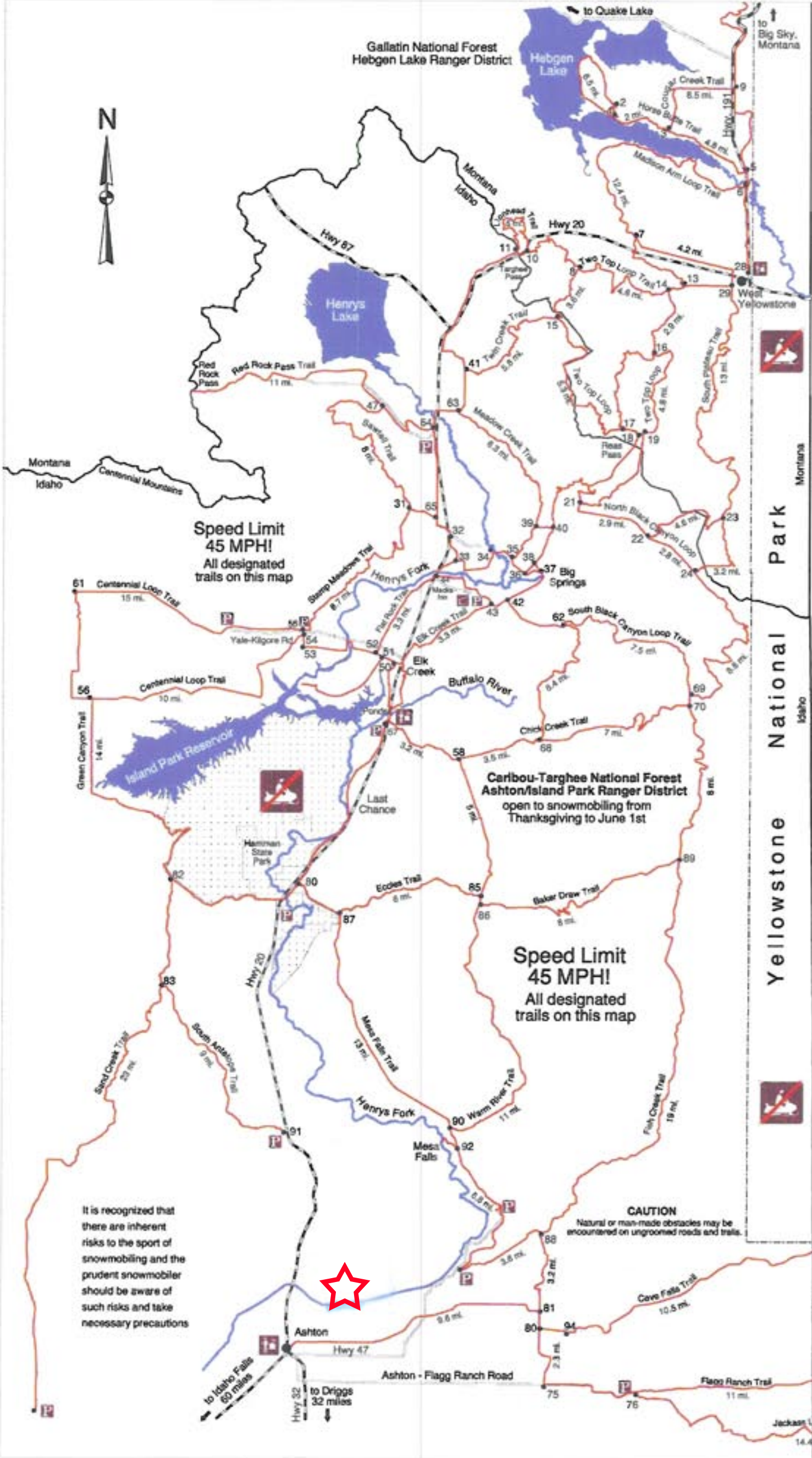
- Operate at safe speeds
- Keep to the right on trails
- Leave trip plans with friend or relative
- Check weather forecast
- Adequately dress for the conditions
- Stay off plowed roads while snowmobiling
- Beware of hazards along trails, including fences, downed trees, cattle guards, plowed roads, and large animals such as moose and elk.
